**Subject:** AN APPEAL TO H.E. GEN. YOWERI MUSEVENI AND THE NRM CAUCUS: RESTORE INTEGRITY TO THE 12TH PARLIAMENT – BRING BACK RT. HON. KADAGA

**KAMPALA, UGANDA:** The YBO Foundation, anchored in its unwavering commitment to Integrity, Accountability, and Effective Representation, hereby addresses His Excellency General Yoweri Kaguta Museveni, President of the Republic of Uganda, and the distinguished members of the National Resistance Movement (NRM) Parliamentary Caucus, on the pivotal matter of electing the Speaker of the 12th Parliament of Uganda.

Our position is unequivocal and grounded in national interest: Uganda's Parliament must restore its dignity, credibility, and constitutional stature by returning the Rt. Hon. Rebecca Alitwala Kadaga to the Speaker's chair.

Parliament stands as the cornerstone of our democracy the institution through which the people's voice is amplified, laws are forged, and executive power is held to account. Yet today, this sacred institution bears the scars of reputational erosion, marked by recurring scandals, hyper-partisanship, and diminishing public trust. Should the President and the NRM leadership be genuinely committed to reversing this trajectory, there exists but one leader whose proven record, institutional memory, moral authority, and independent stature can effect this restoration: Rt. Hon. Rebecca Alitwala Kadaga.

I speak not merely as an observer, but as one who served within the Opposition during the 8<sup>th</sup> Parliament and witnessed firsthand the impartiality, firmness, and procedural rigor with which she presided over the House.

### ***WHY RT. HON. KADAGA IS THE INDISPENSABLE CHOICE FOR SPEAKER OF THE 12<sup>TH</sup> PARLIAMENT***

**1. Unwavering Loyalty to the NRM Cause:** Through seasons of triumph and trial, Kadaga has remained steadfast to the Movement even when subjected to internal marginalization. Her loyalty has never been transactional; it has been principled.

**2. Exemplary Integrity & Institutional Competence:** For ten years, she steered the House with consistency, fairness, and deep respect for parliamentary procedure. Under her gavel, debates were substantive, legislation was processed efficiently, and the dignity of the House was preserved.

**3. Unparalleled Legislative Mastery:** As Uganda's longest-serving female Member of Parliament, she commands an unmatched understanding of parliamentary precedent, constitutional balance, and the delicate equilibrium between Executive authority and Legislative independence.

**4. Age in Context: Vigor Meets Experience:** At 70, Rt. Hon. Kadaga is 15 years younger than H.E. President Museveni, who was recently sworn in for another term at age 85. If age is not a disqualifier for the highest office in the land, it cannot logically preclude qualified leadership of Parliament.

**5. A Beacon for Women's Political Emancipation:** Kadaga shattered glass ceilings and inspired a generation of Ugandan women to pursue public office. Restoring her to the Speaker's chair reaffirms that women's leadership is not symbolic, it is substantive, strategic, and indispensable.

**6. Grassroots Legitimacy & Electoral Mandate:** She commands Kamuli District with overwhelming popular support. This deep connection to the electorate translates into political courage and principled representation within the House.

**7. Independent Judgment under Pressure:** Kadaga has never been a rubber stamp. Even during the highly contentious constitutional amendment on age limits a moment that placed her personal safety at risk, she navigated immense pressure with resilience. Ugandans recognize that her decisions were made under duress, not deference. Parliament requires precisely this caliber of independence to serve as an effective check on executive overreach.

**8. A Unifying National Figure:** As Speaker, she created space for robust debate across party lines, ensuring Parliament functioned as a national institution not merely an extension of the ruling party's caucus.

**9. Restorer of Uganda's Parliamentary Diplomacy:** Under her leadership, Uganda's Parliament commanded respect within the East African Legislative Assembly (EALA), the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association (CPA), and the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU). Today, that international standing requires deliberate rehabilitation and she possesses the stature to reclaim it.

**10. Intellectual Rigor & Strategic Foresight:** The 11<sup>th</sup> Parliament was, by many accounts, hampered by leadership gaps in knowledge and strategic direction. Kadaga offers the antithesis: analytical depth, procedural mastery, and a commitment to evidence-based lawmaking.

**OUR APPEAL:** If President Museveni desires a Parliament that transcends embarrassment and functions as a genuine, co-equal branch of government, the path is clear: reinstate Rt. Hon. Rebecca Kadaga as Speaker. She alone embodies the rare convergence of loyalty, experience, competence, independence, and unifying character required to restore sanity to the House and reclaim Uganda's parliamentary heritage.

Uganda deserves a Legislature that serves the people not patronage networks. The moment for decisive, statesmanlike action is now.

**A SOBER CAUTION:** Any attempt by H.E. Gen. Yoweri Museveni, in his capacity as Chairman and Supreme Leader of the NRM, to impose Hon. Oboth Oboth or any other candidate primarily to advance a narrow, family-centered succession agenda linked to Gen. Muhoozi Kainerugaba through informal structures such as the so-called "PLU," carries profound political risk. Such a move could fracture the NRM's internal cohesion and destabilize the unity of Uganda's Parliament.

To steer the nation toward a governance model reminiscent of the Idi Amin era where military influence supersedes constitutional order would not only be regrettable but deeply ungrateful to the Ugandan people, who have exercised remarkable patience over four decades in pursuit of peace, security, and inclusive development.
